ORDINANCE NUMBER 310.02

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF A BURN BAN

WHEREAS, KRS Chapter 67 authorizes the Grayson County Fiscal Court to enact ordinances to promote the public welfare; and

WHEREAS, KRS 149.401 specifically authorizes this type of burn ban enforcement ordinance to be created by a county of the Commonwealth,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRAYSON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. REGULATIONS

(A) Whenever the Division of Forestry of the Commonwealth notifies the county that an extraordinary fire hazard exists in the county as determined by the national fire danger rating system and fire occurrence, the County Judge Executive is hereby authorized to proclaim, by executive order, that such a condition exists in the county.

(B) No person shall, when a proclamation as provided for in division (A) above has been issued, light or maintain an open fire at any location in the county while such proclamation is in effect.

(C) Notice of the proclamation provided for in division (A) above shall be published in the newspaper of the largest bona fide circulation in the county.

(D) This section shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication.

SECTION II. PENALTY

(A) Any person who violates the provisions of Section (B) may, upon conviction, be fined from \$50 to \$500 for each violation of Section(B).

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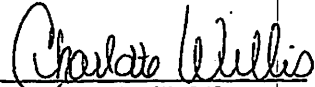
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
