GRAYSON COUNTY FISCAL COURT ORDINANCE ___ | 0.01

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF GRAYSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

That each Magisterial District of Grayson County shall have the following voting precincts, as specifically described herein below, in each district and shall constitute the reapportioned magisterial districts in conformity with KRS 67.045 and the 2020 Decennial Census of the United States:

District #1: with a population of 4,461 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of KY 920 (Salt River Rd.) and County Road 1110 (Kiper Rd.), going south along the centerline of KY 920, crossing into the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023), after approximately 1.33 miles.

Continuing south along the centerline of KY 920 to its intersection with US 62 (Mill St.).

Proceeding west along the centerline of US 62 to its intersection with KY 259 (North Main St.).

Proceeding south along the centerline of US 62 (now North Main St.) becoming Courthouse Sq. and continuing around the east side of the Courthouse becoming South Main St.

Continuing south along the centerline of US 62 (now South Main St.) to its intersection with KY 259 (South Main St.).

Proceeding south along the centerline of KY 259, crossing over WK 9001 (Western KY Pkwy) becoming Anneta Rd. and leaving the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023) approximately 425 feet past its intersection with City Street 1144 (Commerce Dr.).

Continuing south along the centerline of KY 259 to its intersection with County Road 1147 (Bloomington Rd.).

Proceeding southeast along the centerline of County Road 1147 to the point where it crosses over Bear Creek.

Proceeding northeast (upstream) along Bear Creek to its confluence with an unnamed tributary. This confluence is approximately 145 feet from KY 88 (Peonia Rd.) on a sharp curve.

Proceeding southeast (upstream) along this unnamed tributary approximately 145 feet to a point where it passes under KY 88. This point is approximately 345 feet north of its intersection with County Road 1151 (Saint Augustine Rd.).

Proceeding northwest along the centerline of KY 88 to its intersection with KY 1214 (Grayson Springs Rd.).

Proceeding southeast along the centerline of KY 1214 to its intersection with KY 2278 (Rock Creek Rd.).

Proceeding southeast along the centerline of KY 2278 to its intersection with KY 3210 (Rock Creek Rd.).

Proceeding north along the centerline of KY 3210 to its intersection with KY 224 (Millerstown Rd.).

Proceeding east along the centerline of KY 224 to its intersection with KY 1168 (Summit Rd.).

Proceeding east along the centerline of KY 1168 to the point where it crosses over Clifty Creek.

Proceeding northwest (downstream) along Clifty Creek to the point where it passes under KY 920 (Salt River Rd.).

Proceeding south along the centerline of KY 920 to the point of beginning.

District #2: with a population of 4,373 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of US 62 (Beaver Dam Rd.) and KY 2193 (Kefauver Rd.) then proceeding south along the centerline of US 62 to the point where it crosses over Dunns Run.

Proceeding southwest (downstream) along Dunns Run to its confluence with South Fork Caney Creek.

Proceeding southwest (downstream) along South Fork Caney Creek to its confluence with Caney

Proceeding south (upstream) along Caney Fork approximately 750 feet to the point where it passes under the west bound lane of WK 9001 (Western KY Pkwy.).

Proceeding west along the west bound lane of WK 9001 to the point where it passes under KY 79 (Morgantown Rd.).

Proceeding southwest along the centerline of KY 79.to the Grayson/Butler County line.

Proceeding west along the Grayson/Butler County line to a point where it intersects the Grayson/Ohio County line, continuing north to the Grayson/Breckinridge County line which is also Rough River.

Proceeding east along the Grayson/Breckinridge County line and upstream along Rough River to its confluence with Little Clifty Creek.

This is also a point on the boundary between Census Blocks 210859507003015 & and white the transfer of the 210859504023007 which are both hydrography blocks containing no population (1988)

Proceeding south (upstream) along Little Clifty Creek, which is also boundary between Census:

Blocks 210859507003015 & 210859504023007 to its confluence with an unnamed tributary that flows through a geographic feature known as Stones Hollow. This point is approximately 0.84 miles due east of KY 631 (Duff Rd.). Proceeding southwest (upstream) along this unnamed tributary and splitting Census Block 210859507003015 which has no population to a point where it passes under KY 631 (Duff Rd.).

Proceeding east then south along the centerline of KY 631 to its intersection with KY 54 (Owensboro Rd.).

Proceeding southeast along the centerline of KY 54 to a point where it intersects KY 2193

(Kefauver Rd.)

Proceeding southwest along the centerline of KY 2193 to the point of beginning.

District #3: with a population of 4,453 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the confluence of Little Clifty Creek and Rough River on the Grayson/Breckinridge County line.

Proceeding east (upstream) along Rough River and the Grayson/Breckinridge County line to a point where it passes under KY 737 (Lilac Rd.).

Proceeding south along the centerline of KY 737 to a point on the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023) approximately 100 feet northwest of its intersection with City Street 1201 (Wooden Way). This point of the corporate limits was defined in a City of Leitchfield Annexation Ordinance dated 2 June 1997. This is also a point on Census Block 210859504022001.

Proceeding in a northwest direction along the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023) and the edge of Census Block 210859504022001, approximately 0.36 miles to a point where it intersects City Street 1074 (Cave Mill Rd.). This is also a point on Census Block 210859504021013.

Continuing in a northerly direction clockwise around and along the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023) and the edge of Census Block 210859504021013, approximately 2.77 miles to a point where it intersects County Road 1105 (Hanging Rock Rd.) at a point approximately 0.27 miles from its intersection with KY 259 (Brandenburg Rd.)

Proceeding southeast along the centerline of County Road 1105 to its intersection with KY 259 (Brandenburg Rd.).

Proceeding south along the centerline of KY 259, becoming North Main St., to a point where is crosses the P&L Railway tracks

Proceeding southwest along the P&L Railway tracks to a point where they cross KY 2193 (Kefauver Rd.).

Proceeding northeast along the centerline of KY 2193 to its intersection with KY 54 (Owensboro Rd.).

Proceeding northwest along the centerline of KY 54 its intersection with KY 631 (Duff Rd.).

Proceeding north along the centerline of KY 631 to a point where it passes over an unnamed tributary that flows through a geographic feature known as Stones Hollow.

Proceeding northeast (upstream) along this unnamed tributary and splitting Census Block 210859507003015 which has no population to its confluence with Little Clifty Creek. This point is also on the boundary between Census Blocks 210859507003015 & 210859504023007.

Proceeding north (downstream) along Little Clifty Creek and along the boundary between Census Blocks 210859507003015 & 210859504023007 to its confluence with Rough River on the Grayson/Breckinridge County line and the point of beginning.

District #4: with a population of 4,334 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the point on Rough River and the Grayson/Breckinridge County line where it is crossed by KY 737 (Lilac Rd.).

Proceeding north and east (upstream) along Rough River and the Grayson/Breckinridge County line to a point where it intersects the Grayson/Hardin County line, continuing east (upstream) along Rough River and the Grayson/Hardin County line to its confluence with Meeting Creek.

Proceeding east (upstream) along Meeting Creek and the Grayson/Hardin County line to its confluence with Petty Branch.

Proceeding east (upstream) along Petty Branch and the Grayson/Hardin County line to its confluence with an unnamed tributary which is also a corner on the Grayson/Hardin County line.

Proceeding southeast along the Grayson/Hardin County line, crossing US 62 (Elizabethtown Rd.), then WK 9001 (Western KY Pkwy) to a point where it becomes conterminous with the Nolin River.

Proceeding south (downstream) along Nolin River and the Grayson/Hardin County line to its confluence with Nosey Creek.

Leaving the Grayson/Hardin County line and proceeding west (upstream) along-Nosey Creek to the state of the confluence with an unnamed tributary which is also a point on boundary between Census to the state of the Blocks 210859501021009 & 210859501021008.

Proceeding west along the boundary between Census Blocks 210859501021009 & 210859501021008 approximately 1,850 feet to a point where it becomes conterminous with County Road 1165 (Bell Rd.).

Proceeding west along the centerline of County Road 1165 to its intersection with KY 224 (Millerstown Rd.).

Proceeding northwest along the centerline of KY 224 (Millerstown Rd.) to its intersection with KY 1168 (Summit Rd.).

Proceeding east along the centerline of KY 1168 to the point where it crosses over Clifty Creek.

Proceeding northwest (downstream) along Clifty Creek to the point where it passes under KY 920 (Salt River Rd.).

Proceeding south along the centerline of KY 920, crossing into the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023), to its intersection with US 62 (Mill St.).

Proceeding west along the centerline of US 62 to its intersection with KY 259 (North Main St.).

Proceeding north along the centerline of KY 259 to its intersection with County Road 1105 (Hanging Rock Rd.).

Proceeding northwest along the centerline of County Road 1105 approximately 0.27 miles to a point on the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023). This is also a point on Census Block 210859504021013.

Proceeding in a southerly direction, clockwise around the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023) and the edge of Census Block 210859504021013, approximately 2.77 miles to a point where it intersects City Street 1074 (Cave Mill Rd.). This is also a point on Census Block 210859504022001.

Continuing southwest along the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023) and the edge of Census Block 210859504022001, approximately 0.36 miles to a point where it intersects KY 737 (Lilac Rd.). This point is approximately 100 feet northwest of its intersection with City Street 1201 (Wooden Way). This point of the corporate limits was defined in a City of Leitchfield Annexation Ordinance dated 2 June 1997.

Proceeding northwest along the centerline of KY 737 to the point of beginning.

District #5: with a population of 4,447 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east bound lane of the WK 9001 (Western KY Pkwy) where it crosses over McClure Fork. This is between mile marker 105 & 105.1 per KYTC data.

Proceeding southeast (downstream) along McClure Fork to its confluence with Bear Creek.

which is approximately 0.22 miles upstream from where Bear Creek passes under County Road. 1260 (Hooper Barton Rd.). This is also a point that is on the boundary between Census Blocks 210859505003015 & 210859505003021.

Proceeding southeast (upstream) along this unnamed tributary and the boundary between Census Blocks 210859505003015 & 210859505003021 to the Grayson/Edmonson County line.

Proceeding east along the Grayson/Edmonson County line to a point where it becomes conterminous with the Nolin River; continuing east along the Grayson/Edmonson and upstream along the Nolin River to a point where it intersects the Grayson/Hart County line.

Proceeding east then north along Grayson/Hart County line and upstream along the Nolin River to a point where it intersects the Grayson/Hardin County line.

Proceeding east then north along Grayson/Hardin County line and upstream along the Nolin River to its confluence with Nosey Creek.

Leaving the Grayson/Hardin County line and proceeding west (upstream) along-Nosey Creek to it confluence with an unnamed tributary which is also a point on boundary between Census Blocks 210859501021009 & 210859501021008.

Proceeding west along the boundary between Census Blocks 210859501021009 & 210859501021008 approximately 1,850 feet to a point where it becomes conterminous with County Road 1165 (Bell Rd.).

Proceeding west along the centerline of County Road 1165 to its intersection with KY 224 (Millerstown Rd.).

Proceeding northwest along the centerline of KY 224 to its intersection with KY 3210 (Rock Creek Rd.).

Proceeding south along the centerline of KY 3210 to its intersection with KY 2778 (Rock Creek Rd.).

Proceeding west along the centerline of KY 2778 to its intersection with KY 1214 (Grayson Springs Rd.).

Proceeding northwest along the centerline of KY 1214 to its intersection with KY 88 (Peonia Rd.).

Proceeding southwest along the centerline of KY 88 to a point is approximately 345 feet north of its intersection with County Road 1151 (Saint Augustine Rd.). At this point, on a sharp curve, KY 88 crosses over an unnamed tributary of Bear Creek.

Proceeding northwest (downstream) along this unnamed tributary approximately 145 feet to its confluence with Bear Creek.

Proceeding southwest (downstream) along Bear Creek to a point where it passes under County Road 1147 (Bloomington Rd.).

Proceeding northwest along the centerline of County Road 1147 to its intersection with KY 259 (Anneta Rd.).

Proceeding north along the centerline of KY 259, entering the corporate boundary of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023) and becoming South Main St., to a point where it passes over the eastbound lane of the WK 9001 (Western KY Pkwy).

Proceeding west along the east bound lane of the WK 9001, leaving the corporate boundary of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023), to the point of beginning.

District #6: with a population of 4,352 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at intersection of US 62 (North Main St.) and City Street 1006 (Mulberry St.) in the corporate limits of the City of Leitchfield (2023).

Proceeding north along the centerline of US 62 to its intersection with KY 259 (North Main St.)

Proceeding north along the centerline of KY 259 to a point where it crosses over the P&L Railway tracks.

Proceeding southwest along the P&L Railway tracks, leaving the corporate boundary of the City of Leitchfield (as of May 2023), to a point where they cross KY 2193 (Kefauver Rd.).

Proceeding south along the centerline of KY 2193 to its intersection US 62 (Beaver Dam Rd.).

Proceeding southwest along the centerline of US 62 to a point where it crosses over Dunns Run.

Proceeding southwest (downstream) along Dunns Run to its confluence with South Fork Caney Creek.

Proceeding southwest (downstream) along South Fork Caney Creek to its confluence with Caney Fork.

Proceeding south (upstream) along Caney Fork approximately 750 feet to the point where it passes under the west bound lane of WK 9001 (Western KY Pkwy.).

Proceeding southwest along the centerline of KY 79.to the Grayson/Butler County line.

Proceeding southeast along the Grayson/Butler County line to a point where it intersects the Grayson/Edmonson County line, continuing east along the Grayson/Edmonson County line to a point where it is crossed by an unnamed tributary of Bear Creek. This is approximately 0.63 miles east of where County Road 1260 (Hooper Barton Rd.) crosses into Edmonson County.

Proceeding northwest (downstream) along this unnamed tributary to its confluence with Bear Creek.

Proceeding north (upstream) along Bear Creek to its confluence with McClure Fork.

Proceeding north (upstream) along McClure Fork to a point where it crosses under WK 9001 (Western KY Pkwy). This is between mile marker 105 & 105.1 per KYTC data. Proceeding northeast along the east bound lane of the WK 9001, entering the corporate boundary of the City of Leitchfield (2023), to a point where it passes under KY 259 (South Main St).

Proceeding north along the centerline of KY 259 to its intersection with US 62 (South Main St.).

Proceeding north along the centerline of US 62 becoming Courthouse Sq. and continuing around the east side of the Courthouse becoming North Main St. and continuing north to its intersection with City Street 1006 (Mulberry St.) the point of beginning.

The full text of the report of the Reapportionment Committee and its legal description of boundaries of each Magisterial District can be found of record in the Grayson County Fiscal Court Minutes dated Aug 25, 2023 and of record in Fiscal Court Orders Book XXX at Page 457 records of the Grayson County Clerk's Office. A map outlining the Magisterial Districts consistent with the legal descriptions of the Reapportionment Committee is attached hereto and made a part hereof and labeled Exhibit A

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS 67.045(8), any registered voter of the county may enforce the provisions of 67.045 within twenty (20) days of the establishment of the districts by the ordinance.
