ORDINANCE NUMBER 830.3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REGULATING SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court of the County of Grayson of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, has previously adopted on the 24th day of May, 1991, an Ordinance Regulating Solid Waste Management; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance requires all persons engaged in the business of collecting, transporting or processing of solid waste within the county to secure a permit for the operation of said business and the permit is issued for a period of one (1) year upon payment of a fee of \$20.00; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court has determined that said fee should be increased to \$50.00 to cover the increased costs of processing said permits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRAYSON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY;

That Section 6.4 of an ordinance Regulating Solid Waste Management be and hereby is amended to read as follows, with deleted words indicated by a single line drawn through them and added words indicated by a single line drawn underneath them:

Section 6.4: Permit Issuance

If the application shows that the applicant will collect, transport and process solid waste without hazard to the public health or damage to the environment and in conformity with the laws of the State of Kentucky and this ordinance, the Director may issue the permit authorized by the ordinance. The Director shall have the authority to limit the number of permits issued under safety and welfare of the residents to promote energy conservation, and to provide for collection and disposal consistent with good solid waste management practices. The permit shall be issued for a period of one (1) year, and each applicant shall pay a fee of \$20.00 \$50.00. If modifications can be made to the application regarding service, equipment or mode of operation so as to bring the application within the intent of this ordinance, the Director shall notify the applicant in writing setting forth the modifications to be made and the time in which it shall be done.

This Ordinance amending the Ordinance Regulating Sold Waste Management becomes effective immediately upon passage and publication.
