AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAYS AND ACCEPTANCE OF ROADS

WHEREAS, under Kentucky Revised Statute 67.083 (3) (t), Grayson County Fiscal Court may provide for streets and roads.

WHEREAS, Grayson County Fiscal Court through the Grayson County Road Department provides regular and continual maintenance of roadsaccepted into the county road system.

WHEREAS, Grayson County Fiscal Court and the Grayson County Road Department receive numerous requests to accept road and authorize continual maintenance of all accepted roads.

WHEREAS, Grayson County Fiscal Court finds it to be in the best interest of Grayson County to adopt minimum standards and guidelines for the maintenace of county rights-of-ways and minumum standards and guidelines for the acceptenance of roadways into the county system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF GRAYSON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, that the attached "Standards and Policies for Maintenance of County Rights-of-Ways and Acceptance of County Roadways" is incorporated herein by reference is hereby adopted as and shall have full force and effect.

The first reading of this ordinance was held on April 21, 1999.

The second reading and final adoption will be held on Thursday, June 3, 1999 at 2:00 p.m. in the Large Courtroom of the Grayson County Courthouse?

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STANDARDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAYS AND ACCEPTANCE OF ROADS

SECTION I Standards for Road Acceptance

- 1.1 No roadway shall be presented to Grayson Co Fiscal Court for acceptance into Grayson County Road System without first being inspected by the Grayson County Road Supervisor to ensure that the guidelines established by this ordinance and all standards established by state and federal laws are followed.
- No newly built roadway shall be accepted into Grayson County Road System unless a fifty (50) foot if possible but not less than (30) Foot right-of-way has been dedicated to Grayson County in a recorded plat or granted to Grayson County by deed. This does not pertain to any existing road already in the county maintenance system.
- No roadway shall be accepted into Grayson County Road System unless the road way has at a minimum a smooth gravel surface measuring eighteen (18) foot in width, with two foot of shoulder on each side of the road surface.
- No roadway shall be accepted into the county road system unless the roadway has been properly ditched and tiled to ensure adequate drainage of water.
- No roadway shall be accepted into the county road system unless the road banks have been established and have an adequate ground cover to prevent erosion of the soil.
- The Grayson County Road Supervisor may not recommend the acceptance of any road way into the Grayson County Road System without first determining that the acceptance is in the public interest and will serve the general public's interest by facilitating the provision of public services such as but not limited to, mail services, fire protection, police protection, etc.

In addition to other requirements and specifications, a road may be considered for acceptance into the county road system if three (3) of the following five (5) conditions are met: (1) the road has at least three occupied houses per mile: (2) the road is a mail route: (3) the road is a school bus route: (4) the road serves as a farm to market road for cash crops: (5) the road is in the best interest of Grayson County for industry recruitment.

AMMENDMENT RELATING TO AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAYS AND ACCEPTANCE OF ROADS

WHEREAS, all platted subdivisions must have bituminous asphalt pavement with the following thicknesses:

- 6" D.G.A. Base
 3" Bituminous Base
 1" Bituminous Surface
